
Burley Glenwood Elementary

It has four portable classrooms, which have far exceeded their useful life as temporary structures. 

Testing and Test Scores

Smarter Balanced Assessment (SBA)

Beginning in the spring of 2015, the state of Washington began giving a new state assessment called the Smarter Balanced Assessment.

Smarter Balanced Assessment is a comprehensive system designed to measure how well students are learning the Washington State K-12 Standards in English language Arts (ELA) and Math, and is given in grades 3-8 and high school.

SKSD had a 97.8% of its 3rd-5th graders participate in the SBA ELA assessment and 97.9% in mathematics.
